Fees

- 1. Mactier Community Centre annual membership fee is \$10 per family.
- 2. Playgroup Session fee prices are per family. \$3 per session or \$20 per term or \$80 per year.
- 3. Playgroup Vic membership -\$40 per year.

What is the Mactier Community Centre?

The Mactier Community Centre supports Defence families in the greater Melbourne area. Insurance / Playgroup Victoria Membership

All members are required to join Playgroup Victoria for Insurance purposes.

The Playgroup Victoria membership also allows you to attend their great Play days free or at discounted rates.

Safety

Please ensure children are **SUPERVISED** at all times, both inside and out.

Parents must stay within playgroup grounds while their child/ren are attending Playgroup.

Parents are at all times responsible for their child/ren while they attend Playgroup.

Children are not permitted in the Kitchen area.

The First Aid Kit is located in the kitchen. Please make sure you complete an accident/injury report form if you or your child has an accident at playgroup. Forms are kept in the sign in folder.

Sun Smart Policy

Little Macs Playgroup is a Sun Smart organisation. Please ensure that you protect your children from the sun by following the Sun Smart guidelines such as applying sunscreen, wearing hats and encouraging children to use shaded areas in the hottest part of the day.

Healthy Eating

Each session includes a snack time. Little Mac Playgroup encourages you to bring along a healthy snack to share (e.g. a piece of fruit, dry/plain biscuits, sultanas etc.) NO NUTS PLEASE!!

Attendance

There is an attendance sheet for each session which needs to be completed by all attendees every session. This is considered a legal document for insurance purposes so it is imperative that it is completed each session. Please advise the Playgroup rep if you will no longer be attending playgroup as there is often a waiting list for groups.

Maintenance/ Cleaning Procedure

The maintenance of playgroup is the responsibility of **ALL** its members. If you use it, put it away. Groups are encouraged to organise a roster so that the workload is shared. Please remember to look after the equipment. Children should be encouraged to care for the things they use and play with.

End of Session Checklist

- 1. Ensure everyone has signed in.
- 2. Vacuum/Sweep all floors.
- 3. Wash, dry and put away all dishes.
- 4. Wipe down benches and tables with disinfectant.
- 5. Remove all rubbish, food scraps etc.

- 6. Ensure books are on the bookshelf.
- 7. Ensure equipment and toys are put away in correct containers, cupboards or shelves.
- 8. Switch off lights, heaters and fans.
- 9. Ensure external doors and windows are securely locked.

Broken toys / equipment

The Group Rep is to be notified of equipment or toy breakages.
